### Online system to ease traffic collision reporting

MENIFEE-The Menifee Police Department is excited to announce a new service to our community. A citizen's on-line police traffic collision reporting system is now available to the public. Non-emergency, non-injury, minor traffic collisions and hit and run traffic collisions, that have no suspect driver information and no suspect vehicle information, can be reported on-line by going to the City of Menifee website at [www.cityofmenifee.us](http://www.cityofmenifee.us). This service is free to the public and offers a convenient means of creating a police report for minor fender bender traffic collisions that occur within the City of Menifee.

"This new online program provides residents with a convenient, free tool to quickly report non-emergency fender benders and hit and runs. People usually need to report traffic collisions for insurance purposes and this new online tool is simple way to get the information needed to complete the next steps after an accident," said Menifee Police Chief Captain Greg Fellows. "It also gives the Police Department a more streamlined approach to responding to and tracking these incidents, freeing up more time to focus on resident safety."

To submit a non-emergency incident using the online reporting system, residents can follow the link at <https://www.cityofmenifee.us/COPRS>. Upon completion of your on-line traffic collision report, a Menifee Police Officer will review your report for detail and accuracy. Once approved, a Menifee Police Department case number will be provided. In the event the Menifee Police Officer reviewing your traffic collision believes further investigation is required, you will be contacted by phone.
