### **Riverside County Public Health Official Clarify's Faith-Based Services in Public Gathering Order**

**MENIFEE, CA-** Riverside County Public Health Official Cameron Kaiser issued an [Order](#) April 17, based on CA Governor Newsom's April 17<sup>th</sup> Order, further clarifying faith based services as it relates to the existing Public Gatherings and Covered Face Orders. The amended Order, in section one, clarifies that in-person services are prohibited, but drive-up faith based services are permitted- so long as social distancing is followed, and that direct and indirect physical contact is avoided.
