

NOTICE OF MEASURES TO BE VOTED ON

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Menifee on November 3, 2020, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measures:

<p>Shall the measure repealing the voter-approved, locally-controlled Measure DD sales tax generating over \$10,000,000 per year in local funding that cannot be taken by the state used to maintain Menifee 911 emergency response; school and police patrols; street and road repairs; traffic reduction; senior and youth programs; parks and other general services, be adopted?</p>	YES

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN by that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, that the City Council, or any member or members thereof authorized by the City Council, or any individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file written arguments not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the City measures. No more than five authors' names shall appear with any argument.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and sample ballots for the election, the City Clerk has fixed Monday, August 17, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. as the date after which no arguments for or against the City measures may be submitted to the City Clerk for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in Elections Code Article 4. Arguments shall be submitted to the City Clerk at City Hall, 29844 Haun Road, Menifee, California accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization and, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument. Statement by Proponents/Authors of Arguments, is available from the City Clerk. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn by their proponents until and including the date fixed by the City Clerk. If more than one argument for or against a measure is submitted, the City Clerk shall select one of the arguments for and one of the arguments against the measure, in accordance with Elections Code Section 9287.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council has determined that rebuttal arguments, not to exceed 250 words in length, as submitted by the author(s) of the opposing direct arguments, may be filed with the City Clerk, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument. When the City Clerk has selected the arguments for and against the measure, a copy of the argument against the measure will be sent to the author(s) of the argument for the measure and the argument for the measure will be sent to the author(s) of the argument against the measure. Rebuttal arguments must be filed in the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 29844 Haun Road, Menifee, California no later than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 27, 2020.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any ordinance, impartial analysis or direct arguments filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the Clerk's office August 18 through August 27, 2020. Any rebuttal arguments filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the Clerk's office August 28 through September 6, 2020. Copies of the measures are available in the Office of the City Clerk.
