City of Meniffee Celebrates Its Public Works Team During National Public Works Week

Meniffee, CA—Each day, the City of Meniffee's Public Works and Engineering team serves the Meniffee community by planning, building, managing, and operating projects and programs that improve the quality of life for our residents, businesses, and visitors. While the City of Meniffee always appreciates their dedication and hard work, National Public Works week is an opportunity to highlight the important work they do and thank them for their service.

National Public Works Week—May 16 through May 22 this year—was created to educate the public on the important role public works professionals play in the daily lives of Americans. The City of Meniffee's Public Works and Engineering team help make Meniffee the safe, thriving, and premier place that it is.

Projects such as the Paloma Wash Trail Improvements, Murrieta Road Resurfacing Project, and Holland Road Overpass are just a few projects that our team is currently overseeing. And this is on top of the ongoing day-to-day work our small, but mighty Public Works team handles.

In honor of National Public Works Week, the City is proud to share a few exciting updates from our Public Works and Engineering team:

The **Paloma Wash Trail** is a two-mile trail, that will be getting new pavement, hardscape features, landscaping, solar-powered lighting, and a pedestrian crosswalk. The multipurpose trail will also be restriped and new signs will be added. Be on the lookout for the finished improvements this summer.

Meniffee's Public Works Capital Improvement team recently completed installation of approximately 3,800 linear feet of sidewalk, 800 linear feet of curb and gutter, and 7 ADA pedestrian ramps at **Scott Road and Meniffee Road**. This project improves pedestrian accessibility and safety.

The **Murrieta Road Resurfacing Project** will improve pedestrian ADA ramps, signage, and striping along the project area. The portion of the road from McCall Boulevard to Salt Creek began in the fall and the section from Salt Creek to Newport Road will be done after Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) finishes the installation of their water main replacement.

The **McCall Road Resurfacing Project** will rehabilitate approximately two miles of existing pavement from Encanto Road to Oakhurst Avenue. The project will improve signing and striping. In addition, the project will install a pedestrian walkway from Sherman road to Encanto Road.

The Public Works team is also working on many projects that impact the quality of life of residents, including sidewalk removal and replacement, pothole repair (while this is ongoing, they focus on this in particular during this time of year after the rainy season), and dirt road safety grading (also done at the end of rainy season).
