### Public Input Sought on Local Disaster Risk Assessment and Planning

**MENIFEE, CA**— The public is invited to two October meetings to provide input on a City plan that identifies risks from natural and manmade disasters and provides a strategy to minimize losses.

The City's 2021 Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP) update will identify local threats, review and assess past disasters, estimate the probability of future events, and set goals to mitigate potential risks to people and property from earthquakes, floods, wildfires and other hazards.
