5.1. Presentation from Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District

Gayle Hepner and Vince Valdez presented information on the services provided to Menifee residents by Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District. Hepner reported that Riverside County EDA built the new Eller Park and is completing the Romoland Community Center both of which are to be maintained by Valley-Wide. In an agreement with the County, it will quit-claim the deed to both properties to Valley-Wide after an initial 10 year period. Among the facilities at the Community Center is a 40 x 40 community room, available at \$25 per hour. In addition to the ball fields and outdoor play areas, a child care center is planned at the site. After-school activities will be offered as well as full leagues for youth and adults. Valley-Wide operates and maintains 17 parks within the City of Menifee, all of which are on the East side of I-215.
