Letter – A

Bee – Abeja, Tree – Arbol, April - Abril

Craft: Paper Bag Bee



Supplies Needed:

- Paper bag (white or brown)
- Paint (or markers either could be used or both!)
- Googly eyes (construction paper cut into eyes can be used for a substitute)
- Small doilies
- Construction paper
- Glue

Craft: Apple Stamped Tree



Supplies Needed:

- Apples (to substitute the apples you could also use fingerprints, corks for stamps, or handprints)
- Paint
- Construction paper

Colors: Red – Rojo and Green – Verde

Craft: Counting Strawberry

For this craft, 2 different skills can be practiced, math skills can be practiced when the child counts how many “seeds” (black dots) go onto each strawberry and color skills (red and green or rojo y verde)



Supplies Needed:

- Construction paper
- Paint or markers
- Glue

*Please make sure to use smaller numbers for the strawberries such as 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5! Enjoy!

Craft: Paper Plate Turtle



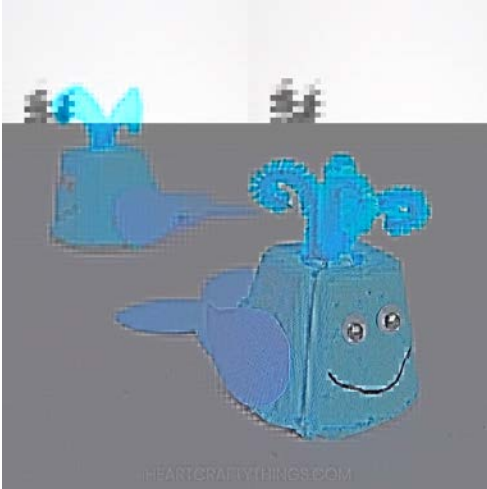
Supplies Needed:
