A vibrant, young city situated in the heart of Southwest Riverside County along Interstate 215, Menifee is one of the few communities in Southern California with available land in an economic development corridor. This business-friendly city is investing more than \$170 million in infrastructure and traffic improvement projects over the next five years.



Recognized as one of the top 10 cities for growth in Southern California with a 2.4 percent growth rate per year, and a median age of 38 years, Menifee is attracting young families that are clamoring for shopping, dining and entertainment amenities in their own community. As more developers are discovering this unique situation, Menifee is buzzing as the new hot spot in Riverside County.

Economic potential

In Menifee, a retail, dining and amenity leakage gap of more than \$890 million exists. This leakage gap combined with a growing population desiring more amenities closer to home makes Menifee an undiscovered gem for retail/commercial development in Southwest Riverside County.
