

**1. RRP Acknowledgement**

As the property owner or contractor preparing to do work on a Pre-1978 Building I have read the explanation of the Renovation Repair Painting Rule and will ensure that any paint disturbing work will be done by or supervised by an RRP certified individual(s).

EPA's lead Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule (RRP Rule) requires that firms performing renovation, repair and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint in homes, child care facilities and pre-schools built before 1978 have their firm certified by EPA (or an EPA authorized state), use certified renovators who are trained by EPA-approved training providers and follow lead-safe work practices.

Failure to follow this rule may result in enforcement action by the EPA.

**2. Special Condition #1:**

Any paint disturbing work on a Pre-1978 building shall be done by or supervised by an EPA certified individual(s) and follow Lead Renovation, Repair, and Painting Rule (RRP Rule). Failure to follow this rule may result in enforcement action by the Federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

**3. WARNING**

Structures built prior to 1978 may contain lead-based paint. The owner/Contractor understands and agrees that an EPA Certified Firm shall be used for the disturbance of any painted surfaces or materials.
